

URSINUS COLLEGE FOREIGN LANGUAGE SUBSTITUTION POLICY

After receiving approval for a language substitution accommodation through the Office of Disability and Access, students and advisors should refer to the following guidelines for course selection:

- 1. Two language-driven courses from the same linguistic sphere. By language-driven we mean courses with a heavy reliance on translated texts, or involving screening of media in the same language with subtitles. The preference is thus for literary courses and film courses.
- 2. The other option is to do one course in keeping with the descriptions in (1), plus MCS-350 Intercultural Communication.
