After receiving approval for a language substitution accommodation through the Office of Disability and Access, students and advisors should refer to the following guidelines for course selection:

1. Two language-driven courses from the same linguistic sphere. By language-driven we mean courses with a heavy reliance on translated texts, or involving screening of media in the same language with subtitles. The preference is thus for literary courses and film courses.
2. The other option is to do one course in keeping with the descriptions in (1), plus MCS-350 Intercultural Communication.
